Introduction

Thank you for purchasing AUDIFIED 1A Equalizer. 1A Equalizer is a model of a legendary tube-based equalizer from the 1950s. Our version of this popular plugin features three typical sections: Low end with Boost, Attenuation and Low Frequency controls; Mid/High peak controls with selective Bandwidth, Boost and High Frequency knobs; and High-end controls to Attenuation and Frequency of the high shelf filter. 1A Equalizer also includes useful Calibration, THD meter for overall distortion of the amplifier, and handy Output Gain to make it work in all your tracks. 1A Equalizer works great to bring warmth and punch to your bass, cutting specific frequencies on drums or bringing beautifully modeled character to the final mix or master.

Software Installation

Get the recent version of the plug-in from your user account on our website:


- Windows: If the downloaded file is packed, unzip it. Run the installer and follow the
 on-screen instructions. You can select the destination path and the installed plug-in format
 during the process.
- Mac: Mount the downloaded disk image and run the installer. You can select the installed plug-in format by clicking the Customize button. Plug-ins are installed in the standard locations.

Product activation

Starting with version 1.0.0, you will automatically create an account via checkout if you are a first-time buyer. You can also sign in to your account anytime on our site <u>audified.com</u> via the Account icon in the right corner to access your Account dashboard.

Upon completing the purchase, you will receive an automatic email containing your serial numbers and the download link for your purchased products.

When you first launch the plugin, you will be asked to enter the serial number, or you can use the product for a limited time as a trial.



Software Uninstallation

- **Windows**: Navigate to the 1A Equalizer program folder in the Start menu and run the uninstaller.
- Mac: Open the provided disk image and run the uninstaller.

Opening the plug-in

AUDIFIED 1A Equalizer works in all major digital audio workstations (recording applications) as a plug-in.

To open the plug-in, locate the plug-in selection (usually a hierarchic menu). 1A equalizer is listed in the Equalizer group or in the AUDIFIED group when the manufacturer sorting is offered.

Working with 1A Equalizer

Control overview



Preset management

Presets can be loaded and saved in the display area.

- The left button offers a selection from a preset list, structured in several submenus.
- The mid button opens a menu allowing users to save or delete user presets.

Services menu

A click to the burger menu opens the Services menu. Services menu allows access to:

- user manual,
- product updates,
- feedback form on the Audified web,
- support,
- Audified website,
- product version and other info,
- license information.

Utility menu

Clicking the wrench symbol opens the utility menu. You can easily copy the state of one plugin instance to the other instance using Copy and Paste functionality.

Signal chain sections

The plug-in controls can be divided into several processing blocks.

Low end controls



Boost Set the boost of low frequencies that will be fed to the amplifier.

Atten Set the amount of low shelving attenuation filter.

Low Frequency Select the focus frequency of the boost and low shelving filter.

Mid/high peak filter controls



Boost Set the boost of the peak filter before the amplifier.

Bandwidth Set the width of the peak filter.

High Frequency Select the focus frequency of the filter.

High end controls



Atten Set the amount of attenuation of the high shelving filter.

Atten Select Select the critical frequency of the high shelving filter.

Calibration

Calibration Set calibration of the whole plugin to

control the amount of saturation.

THD meter Displays amount of added harmonics.



LR-MS switch

L=R Select the channel you want to edit or link them together.

L/R M/S mode Select between Left-Right or Mid-Side processing. It makes

no sense to use MS mode when the channels are linked.





If you are not familiar with MS recording, refer to recording practices in books or online to learn how to utilize the MS mode.
