## Software Installation

---

Get the recent version of the plug-in from your user account on our website:

**Webpage:** [audified.com/account/downloads](https://audified.com/account/downloads)

- **Windows:** If the downloaded file is packed, unzip it. Run the installer and follow the on-screen instructions. You can select the destination path and the installed plug-in format during the process.
- **Mac:** Mount the downloaded disk image and run the installer. You can select the installed plug-in format by clicking the Customize button. Plug-ins are installed in the standard locations.

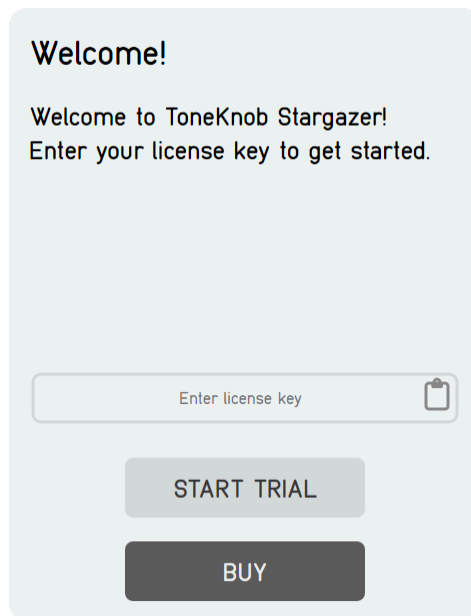
## Product activation

---

Starting with version 1.0.0, you will automatically create an account via checkout if you are a first-time buyer. You can also sign in to your account anytime on our site [audified.com](https://audified.com) via the Account icon in the right corner to access your Account dashboard.

Upon completing the purchase, you will receive an automatic email containing your serial numbers and the download link for your purchased products.

When you first launch the plugin, you will be asked to enter the serial number, or you can use the product for a limited time as a trial.



## Software Uninstallation

---

- **Windows:** Navigate to the ToneKnob Stargazer program folder in the Start menu and run the uninstaller.
- **Mac:** Open the provided disk image and run the uninstaller.

## Opening the plug-in

---

AUDIFIED ToneKnob Stargazer works in all major digital audio workstations (recording applications) as a plug-in.

To open the plug-in, locate the plug-in selection (usually a hierarchic menu). ToneKnob Stargazer is listed in the Reverb group or in the AUDIFIED group when the manufacturer sorting is offered.

# Working with ToneKnob Stargazer

## Utility menu

---

Clicking the wrench symbol opens the utility menu. You can easily copy the state of one plugin instance to the other instance using Copy and Paste functionality.

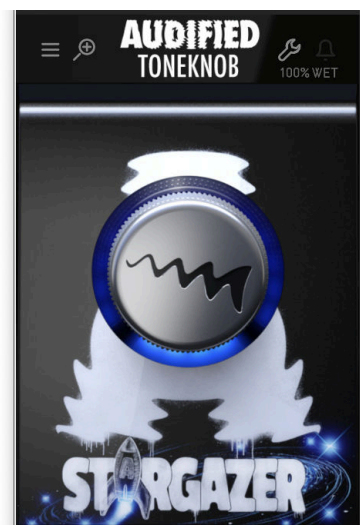
## Indication Ring

ToneKnob Stargazer doesn't rely on meters or numbers. For us, it's a way to relax and focus solely on the essentials of finding the right reverb sound – sound, our ears, and our taste. As a visual aid, the light ring around the knob indicates the amount of reverb applied and its complexity.

## Dialing in Stargazer

### Up to 25%

In this range, use Stargazer as a practical reverb, basically applicable to any signal source. However, you don't have to bother with all the values like in other reverbs such as Decay, Pre-Delay, Damping, Density, and so on... We did that for you, so just enjoy the great sound. **Want more reverb? Just turn the knob further to the right**



### 25-50%

Here you get a really long and full reverb, which you must handle carefully in the mix. It can serve well on **backing vocals, strings, winds** or if the track has a slower tempo and you need a deliberately long reverb.



## 50-100%

In this range you enter the world of ambient music and sound design. Put Stargazer on the track of an acoustic or electric **guitar, synthesizer, piano...** really anything you can think of, here there are no limits. It always surprises us what Stargazer does to the sound, and we're sure you'll love it too.



## 100% Wet

The **100% Wet** function means that only the affected sound (reverberated signal) goes to the plugin output, while the original, "dry", i.e., your instrument/signal, is completely removed. The **100% Wet** function is key in **parallel signal processing**, where the affected (wet) sound is separated from the original (dry) signal on a separate aux channel. This allows for easy mixing of the clean and affected signals, even for multiple tracks simultaneously. When creating ethereal textures, large ambient soundscapes, the separated wet signal also sounds impressive.

- 100 MB of disk space required.
